Location:-

Sadguru Education Society (Nr Khwajamiyan Dargah, Ganesh Colony) is 0.5 km from Jalgaon Railway Station and 0.5 km from Bus Terminus. Buses Autorickshaw and Taxies are available on nominal fare.

Jalgaon is located in western India, to the north of the Maharashtra state, which itself is located on the northern Deccan Plateau. Located within the productive, irrigated agricultural region of Khandesh. Jalgaon has a Municipal Corporation which is home to 460,468 inhabitants at the 2011 census. Jalgaon is connected with Central Railway Zone and National Highway No.6 and has Airport.

Modern Jalgaon now has major Industrial areas, Educational institute, good hospitals and University. The city is well developed with good road, shopping malls, residential areas, and also has good communication and transport infrastructure. Known as "Banana-City", it contributes to about half of the Maharashtra state's Banana production

Road : Jalgaon is not only connected to the major cities of Maharashtra state but also to the cities like Mumbai, Nagpur, Durg, Raipur, Sambalpur and Kolkata through Asian Highway no. 46 (formerly National Highway no. <u>6</u>).

Rail: Jalgaon railway station lies on the main railway line. Trains like Karnataka, Navjeevan, Jabalpur Garibrath Express, etc. have a stop at Jalgaon. Recently some more express trains like Gitanjali, Goa, Mahanagari, Kamayani, Bareli Express, Taptiganga and Sachakhand have also been provided with stoppage. Though an important city and district place, many of the trains stop at Bhusawal due to operational convenience of Railways. Bhusawal railway junction, which is exactly 25 kilometers away from Jalgaon city, is one of the major railway junctions in Maharashtra. It connects the city with Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata, Chennai, etc. Jalgaon also connect to big western Indian city surat' by tapti rail line. Jalgaon have special train starting from Bhusaval to education hub Pune via commercial capital of India Mumbai.

Air : Jalgaon Airport, at Kusumba (approximately 6 km from the city) has been upgraded by the AAI and was inaugurated on 23 March 2012 by the President of India, Smt Pratibha Patil. Airlines like JetLite and Kingfisher Red have shown interest in starting services between Jalgaon and Mumbai but all have seemed futile. All the citizens of Jalgaon have to access Aurangabad airport (150 KM) to gain access to air services.

Mehrun Lake : "Mehrun" is another famous spot in the district for its famous fruit 'Bor'. A fun park is located nearby the premises as well. Supposedly the name Jalgaon is inspired by Mehrun Lake, meaning of 'Jal' being water

Ajanta Caves : The famous Ajanta Caves are located at distance of 50 km from Jalgaon. These caves were carved by Buddhists and one of the most famous Tourist Destination.

Sai Baba Temple (Shirdi) : is 235km far from Jalgaon. Number of bushes and taxi services are available for to and fro journey.
